## Overstocked Fish Roe by Japanese?

Research by the Division of Economic Enterprise indicates extensive Japanese purchases of

salmon, and fish roe, which resulted in record high prices for Alaska fishermen in 1973, may have been a mistake. It now appears the Japanese may have overstocked on what are essentially luxury items and

there could be a drastic drop in purchases next year. If this is the case, it could affect the price fishermen receive for their 1974 catches, the divi-

sion reports.
