

# Telephones asked for pipeline

The Alaska Public Utilities Commission has ordered a public hearing in the matter of the competing applications of the Fairbanks Municipal Utilities System and Interior Telephone Company to furnish temporary local telephone exchange public

utility service to 14 pipeline construction camps located north of Fairbanks.

The public hearing will be convened at 1 p.m., Tuesday, Jan. 29 in the City Council Chambers, Fairbanks.

The commission received responses to these applications from Alyeska Pipeline Service Co., acting as agent for and on behalf of Amerada Hess Corp., ARCO Pipeline Co., Exxon Pipeline Co., Mobil Pipeline Co., Phillips Petroleum Co., SOHIO Pipeline Co., and Union Oil Co. of Calif., and separately from BP Alaska, Inc., RCA Alaska Communications, Inc., Mobil Oil Corp., and Atlantic Richfield Co.
