INVITATION FOR BIDS STATE OF ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF HIGHWAYS

Sealed bids in single copy for furnishing all labor, materials, and equipment, and performing all work on Project F-031-2(28) & F-044-1(4), Pedestrian Overcrossing described herein, will be received until 2:00 p.m. prevailing time, in the Commissioner's Office, Department of Highways, Island Center Building, Douglas, Alaska.

This project will consist of construction of steel girder pedestrian overcrossing on the Seward Highway at Rabbit Creek School, and on 44th Avenue at Willow Crest School. The work is located in Anchorage, Alaska.

Items of work consist of the following: 360 cubic yards of Class I Excavation; approximately 171 cubic yards of Class A Concrete, lump sum, all required; approximately 12,900 pounds of Reinforced Steel, lump sum, all required; 204 linear feet of Cast-in-place Concrete Piles; approximately 235,500 pounds of Structural Steel, lump sum, all required; approximately 22,200 board feet of untreated timber; 7,610 square feet of Roofing System; and 6,670 square feet of Girding System, lump sum, all required.

All work will be completed in 170 calendar days.
