In May 1972 the seven-class-room BIA school at Chevak was totally destroyed by fire of unknown origin. Stevens received a petition from Richard Birchell, Supt. BIA, Bethel, Birchell, signed by the city council of Chevak and 371 villagers requesting funds to reconstruct the school.

In March 1972 Stevens was informed by the BIA that construction of the Alakanuk school was being held up because only half of the village had moved to the new village site across the Yukon and two miles upstream.




