

BBNC re-elects Samuelsen

DILLINGHAM—Bristol Bay Native Corp. shareholders in their second annual meeting held Nov. 1 in Dillingham voted to reduce their 35-member board to 12.

At the Saturday meeting, the shareholders also nominated and elected a new 12-man board.
