

Arts Council Established At Bethel

A Council on the Arts has been established in Bethel and plans its first major event for July 4. At that time it will open a museum in the city and will hold an auction of handmade items.

Headed by Nancy Hohman, the council also plans to co-sponsor with the Woman's Club a puppet show for children during the summer using native stories and puppets made by the students of the school.

Other events tentatively scheduled are: a graphics show by Nancy Hohman—July 4, a photography exhibit and show by Joerene Hout—Sept. 17, a skin sewing workshop in October, a winter carnival arts and crafts show in January and a visit from a ballet troupe.

In addition to opening the museum, goals adopted by the council are to encourage traditional native arts and to locate a building to house an arts and crafts workshop where people could come and work and also sell their items.
