



The Alaska Division of Energy and Power development has received word from the Small Business Administration that loans up to \$350,000 are available for Alaskan Businesses to start up, continue or expand in developing, manufactoring, selling, installing or servicing of specific energy measures.

Eligible energy measures covered by the loan program include:

- Solar heating systems
- Photovoltaic cells and related equipment
- Products or services which increase the energy efficiency of existing equipment, methods of operation, or systems which use fossil fuels
- Production of energy from biomass
- eIndustrial consideration of energy, district heating or production of energy from industrial waste
- Hydroelectric equipment
- Wind energy conversion equipment
- Engineering, architecture, consulting or other professional services to gid citizens in using any of the above measures


