State Gets Grant

WASHINGTON-A \$305,466 grant has been awarded to the State of Alaska from the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration under the Coastal Energy Impact Program, according to Sen. Mike Gravel, D-Alaska.

The funds are to be used to develop and implement a system for allocating program monies to local agencies within the State and for planning for the social, economic and environmental consequences of specific energy facilities.

The \$305,466 grant comes from the Office of Coastal Zone Management of the Commerce Department and will be administered by the Alaska Department of Community and Regional Affairs.
