

KBRW receives ASRC donation

Jacob Adams, president of the Arctic Slope Regional Corp., has advised the Alaska Public Radio Network and APRN member station KBRW in Barrow of the corporation's support for National Native News.

A check was received from ASRC in the amount of \$10,400 to support local broadcast of National Native News on KBRW for one year, and two months of support for the national broadcast through APRN.

"We believe that KBRW provides important local public radio services," Adams said. "We hope that our contribution encourages others to likewise invest to help make the National Native News broadcast a continuing service."

National Native News is a daily program aired on 21 stations throughout the state, as well as on 40 to 50 public radio stations in the Lower 48.
