Utility Corridor Draft Resource Management Plan and Environmental Impact Statement Public Meeting and Public Hearing

The Arctic District Office of the Bureau of Land Management will hold a public meeting in Barrow, Alaska. This meeting will provide a forum to discuss and take formal comments on the Utility Corridor Draft Resource Management Plan and Environmental Impact Statement. One part of this meeting will be a general discussion of BLM's proposed recommendations for managing natural resources throughout the planning area. The second part of the meeting will consist of two formal public hearings. The first of these hearings will address the wilderness proposal of the draft plan. The second hearing will address the subsistence uses and needs within the planning area. The public is encouraged to attend both the general meeting and the formal public hearings to express their views on BLM's management recommendations in this draft management plan.

For those unable to attend the sessions during the daytime, there will also be meeting and hearing sessions in the evening.

Meeting and Hearing Schedule Barrow, September 29, 1987

The general public meetings and the formal hearings will be held in the North Slope Borough Assembly Chambers, September 29, 1987. The daytime general meeting is scheduled to begin at 9 a.m. and will end at 11:30 a.m. The formal public hearing on the wilderness proposal will begin at 1 p.m. and end at 2:45 p.m. The formal hearing on the subsistence aspects of the management plan will begin at 3 p.m. and end at 5 p.m.

The evening session will begin at 6:30 p.m. with a short summary of the Resource Management Plan. The formal hearing on the wilderness proposal will begin at 7:30 p.m. and will end at 8:30 p.m. The formal hearing on subsistence will begin at 8:45 p.m. and will end at 9:45 p.m.

The Bureau of Land Management encourages and looks forward to your participation in the general meeting and both hearings. Individual or group comments on the draft proposals will greatly aid in the formulation of the final resource management plan.
