

CBS Plans to Nationally Televisify Tanacross Land Affair in Sept.

The Columbia Broadcasting System's Mike Wallace 60 Minute Show will include Chief Andrew Isaac, his people, Rep. William Hensley and other personalities for 20 minutes on the land problems of native Alaskans especially those of Chief Isaac.

The show will be screened nationally some time in September according to Paul Loewenwarter, assistant to Mike Wallace.
