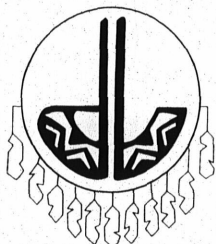

## Notice of Availability of Draft Environmental Assessment and Public Hearing for Proposed Airport Relocation at TUNTUTULIAK AIRPORT Project No. 51793

The Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities (DOT&PF) proposes to relocate the airport at Tuntutuliak, located 45 miles southwest of the community of Bethel in southwest Alaska. The proposed airport would be located approximately one mile east of the existing airport.

A draft environmental assessment (EA) has been prepared for the proposed project describing the alternatives considered and explaining the probable economic, social, and environmental effects of the proposed project and its consistency with the goals and objectives or such community planning as has been carried out by the community of Tuntutuliak.
