# AFN-JOM Sponsors Workshop

The Alaska Federation of Natives, Inc./Johnson O'Malley Program is sponsoring a two-day Workshop for Sub-Contractors, to be held Oct. 21-22 in Anchorage.

With Fiscal Year 1976 Programs beginning operation, the Workshop is designed to give sub-contractors technical assistance in the programmatic and fiscal requirements of Johnson O'Malley. JOM staff will work with sub-contractors, both

individually and as a group, to answer questions and provide information. All 54 sub-contractors will be represented at the Workshop by both a program representative and a bookkeeping/accountant representative. Highlights of the Workshop will include discussion on: How You Can Measure the Importance of Your Program; How to Increase Community Involvement; and How to Get Your Money.

In conjunction with the Workshop the JOM staff will host a welcome dinner/get-together for sub-contractors on Monday evening, the night before the Workshop is scheduled to begin.

The Workshop and dinner will be held at the Cook Inlet Native Association Building (AFN Offices) 670 West Fireweed Lane, with the Dinner beginning at 6:30 p.m., and the Workshop beginning Tuesday morning at 8:30 a.m.

It determines needs, sets priorities and allocates federal funds appropriated for training personnel in alcoholism work.


Ms. Simeone plans to use her grant to complete the first year of a Master of Science degree in Community Resource Specialist (Alcoholism).
