The Alaska Energy Office, 338 Denali Street, Anchorage, passes on the following conservation tip to help save Alaska's energy and Alaskan's money.

Don't be in such a hurry to step on your car accelerator when the light turns green, accelerate smoothly and you'll slow down the drain on your pocketbook for gasoline, and save more of Alaska's resources.

Drive at moderate speeds, especially in these icy conditions. Most cars get 21% more miles per gallon on the highway at 55 miles per hour than they do at 70 miles per hour.
