

AT THE MUSHERS DRAWING for the start of the 1979 Fur Rendezvous the crowd was treated to an introduction of three of the original mushers who made the "serum run" from Nenana to Nome in 1925. Edgar Kalland on the left took the badly needed serum from nine mile to Kokrine's, a distance of 30 miles.
