

Elections at C.I.N.A.

Jake Lestenkof, executive director of Cook Inlet Native Association Inc., reports that at their regular monthly meeting on November 17, 1977, the C.I.N.A. Board of Directors elected the following officers: Jerry Gularte, chairman; Robert Rude, president; Walter Riley, vice-president; Charles Akers, treasurer; Tim Twitchell, sergeant of arms, and re-elected Mrs. Tanya Gularte secretary.

Cook Inlet Native Association further announced the appointment of Christine Kashevarof of Seldovia and Alfred Goozmer of Tyonek to the 15-member Board of Directors.

Kashevarof, 33, is a lifelong resident of Seldovia and has been a secretary for the Indian Health Service, Department of Environmental Health for seven years. Mrs. Kashevarof is active in her community as a director on the Seldovia Native Association's Board of Directors, is chairperson on the Cook Inlet Native Committee for Health, is district chairperson for Indian Education (Title IV), Kodiak School District, chairperson for Seldovia's Title IV Committee, and a director on the Seldovia Health, Education and Welfare Board.

Goozmer, 28, is an active member of the Tyonek Village Council and is a Tyonek Native Corporation Board member. He was also on the Overall Economic Development Planning Board for Kenai Peninsula as the Tyonek Representative. Goozmer was active in working on the Indian Self-Determination Act.
