

PUBLIC NOTICE NOTICE OF UTILITY TARIFF FILING

NOTICE OF UTILITY TARIFF FILING

The ALASKA PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION hereby gives notice that RCA ALASKA COMMUNICATIONS, INC. (RCAA), the sole long lines telecommunications common carrier in the State, has filed a tariff revision (TA112-98) consisting of a request for a 95% permanent rate increase to be applied to all long lines services provided between points within the State of Alaska. The increase would affect all public and private channel and equipment services: i.e., toll message telephone, private line, telex, public telegraph, money order services, marine radiotelephone, rural radiotelephone, rural wire telephone service, subscriber terminal equipment offerings, and special contracts. RCAA has stated that the 95% rate increase will provide approximately \$20,485,666 additional annual revenue which will result in a 5.7% return on the utility's rate base, using 1976 test year data.

Any customer at present receiving any type of intrastate service from RCAA can determine the approximate effect of the requested increase by applying a multiplier of 1.95 to the appropriate rate schedule or billing invoice related to the service.

More detailed information may be obtained from the utility whose address is 949 E. 36th, Anchorage, Alaska 99502. The filing is available for inspection also at the offices of the Alaska Public Utilities Commission, 1100 MacKay Building, 338 Denali Street, Anchorage, Alaska 99501.

Any interested person may file with the Commission by 4:30 P.M., January 12, 1978, a statement of views and specific reasons in favor of, or in opposition to, the tariff revision proposed by the utility, together with written confirmation that the same statement also has been mailed or delivered to the utility.
