Fairbanks to receive new tower

A new air traffic control tower costing more than \$1.5 million will be built at Fairbanks International Airport, the Federal Aviation Administration announced last week.

The announcement was made by Lyle K. Brown, Director of FAA's Alaskan Region.

Although cost of the new structure is estimated at \$1.5 to \$2.5 million, actual construction cost cannot be determined until bids for the contract are opened in Anchorage on March 20.

Construction of the new Fairbanks tower is expected to get underway this summer. The anticipated completion date is August, 1978.
