

Governor to Attend Dogsled Races

The Dog Musher's Association is planning a big weekend at Farmer's Loop Road highlighted by the Open North American Championship Sled Dog Race, Friday, Saturday, and Sunday.

Gov. Keith Miller plans to attend the Sunday race.

The first heat is Friday at 1 p.m. with the second and third heats being Saturday and Sunday at 1:30 p.m.

Both Saturday and Sunday there will be sled dog rides for spectators and a display of different types of sleds, harnesses and dogs.

Also on Saturday there will be a junior snowshoe race, a three-legged snowshoe race for adults, a weight pulling contest using a team of three dogs, children's nickel scramble, and a tea boiling contest.

Gov. Miller will award the Governor's Cup to the winner of the sled dog races at the Musher's Banquet Sunday night at the Little Switzerland.
