ANAKTUVUK PASS PRECINCT.

4. The qualifications of voters:

(1) is a citizen of the United States, qualified to vote in the State of Alaska elections;

(2) has been a resident of the North Slope Borough for 30 days immediately preceding the date of the election;

(3) is registered to vote in State of Alaska elections;

(4) is not disqualified under Article V of the Constitution of the State of Alaska.

5. The type of election, general or special: The election is a special election.

6. The propositions submitted to the electors are:

a. The election of two persons to fill the position of assemblyman of the North Slope Borough;

b.
