

Schwind named Mauneluk president

Mauneluk Association, the non-profit regional corporation based in Kotzebue, has chosen Marie Schwind, a Native of Deering to replace Dennis Tiepelman as president.

She will assume her new duties on June 1. Tiepelman is moving to Washington to serve as representative there for the Alas-

ka Federation of Natives.

Schwind came to work for Mauneluk in January, 1976 as a health planner and was promoted to her present position of executive vice-president on October of that year.

Tiepelman had headed up the corporation for five years.
