TO DEVELOP IN A WETLAND AND FLOODPLAIN  
HIGHWAY PROJECT NO. X-14615  
FUNNY RIVER ROAD

This notice is to comply with public notice procedures under Executive Order 11990, Protection of Wetlands and Executive Order 11988, Floodplain Management. The Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities, Central Region, proposes to construct a bridge across River mile 34 of the Kenai River. This bridge will connect Rabbit Run Road with Scout Lake Loop Road. The roadway will be realigned and topped with a hot bituminous pavement. Approximately 44,000 cubic yards of fill will be placed onto wetlands.
