

Indian Arts and Crafts Board Announces Preview Exhibition

The Southern Plains Indian Museum and Crafts Center, administered by the Indian Arts and Crafts Board of the U.S. Department of the Interior, announced the opening preview of a special Exhibition, **PAINTINGS BY ALFRED WHITEMAN**, on Sunday afternoon, November 12 from 1:00 to 4:30 P.M.

INGS BY ALFRED WHITEMAN will be on view to the public through December 16.

Viewing hours are 9 A.M. to 4:30 P.M. Tuesday through Saturday and 1:00 to 4:30 P.M. Sundays, closed Mondays.

Alfred Whiteman, Jr., of Cheyenne/Arapaho descent, was born in 1928 in Colony, Oklahoma. Whiteman, whose Indian name is "Sitting Bear," graduated from El Reno High School,

El Reno, Oklahoma in 1948.

From 1959 to 1962, Whiteman studied commercial art and drafting at Oklahoma State School of Technical Training in Okmulgee. In 1962, Whiteman became artist and designer for Oklahoma State University Division of Public Information, a position he held for eight years.

At present, Whiteman and his family are residing in Lolo, Montana; — where his wife,

Henrietta, is associated with the American Indian Studies Program at the University of Montana.

Both Mr. and Mrs. Whiteman will be present at the opening preview of his one-man show at the Southern Plains Indian Museum and Crafts Center on November 12.

Included in the Special Exhibition are twelve works which exemplify Alfred Whiteman's

virtuosity in the use of color, gradations, design and form. Many of the works will be available for sale.

The Oklahoma Indian Arts and Crafts Cooperative which operates the Gallery/Shop in the Southern Plains Indian Museum and Crafts Center will assist the Museum staff in hosting the Special Exhibition preview.

Refreshments will be served throughout the afternoon event, compliments of the Oklahoma Indian Arts and Crafts Cooperative.

A four page, illustrated brochure entitled "Paintings by Alfred Whiteman" has been published by the Indian Arts and Crafts Board's Southern Plains Indian Museum and Crafts Center in conjunction with the special Exhibition.

Copies of the brochure are available free to the public.

Police Training

Merril Nashookook of Barrow graduated from the third Municipal Police Training School in Sitka. Commissioner of the Department of Public Safety, Emery W. Chapple, Jr. presented certificates for completion of the 230 hour course at a dinner Friday evening.

Commissioner Chapple, in a short speech to the 17 graduates, commented on the continuing success of the school and expressed appreciation for the many visiting lecturers who gave freely of their time such as Dr. William Brady, medical examiner for the State of Washington, and George Ishii, criminologist and director of the Seattle Crime Lab.

Graduates of the school represented 13 communities in Alaska including Kotzebue, Barrow, Metlakatla, Bethel, Fairbanks, Juneau, Ketchikan, Sitka, Kenai, Soldotna, Valdez, Kodiak, and Palmer.

Principal purpose of the school is to keep police officers posted on the latest techniques in the field of law enforcement and emergency medical treatment; and to serve as a refresher course for veteran policemen.

The Municipal Police Training Program is funded by Law Enforcement Assistance Act funds, and by the Department of Public Safety.
