

Egegik fourth grader wins Rural Art Contest

Corrine Johnson, a fourth grade student from Egegik was named grand prize winner in the 1982 Alaska Rural Children's Art Contest.

She was one of 55 children receiving prizes in the contest which is sponsored annually by the Alaska Native Medical Center Auxiliary contest.

Children from 50 rural school districts submitted 245 individual art entries in the contest.

The entries were judged by Myrna Clark, art curriculum coordinator for the Anchorage School District.

In each grade kindergarten through the eighth there was

one first prize, two second prizes and three third prize winners. Each entrant will receive a Certificate of Merit from the Auxiliary.

The Grand Prize winner will receive \$100; First Prize winners, \$30 each; Second Prize winners, \$15 each and Third Prize winners, \$10 each.

All award winners will have their art work framed and hung in the hospital as part of the continuing beautification program sponsored by the Auxiliary.

This year's winners will bring the total number of children's art on display to 218 pictures. The contest originated in 1979. Also, during the month of June all winners will be displayed at the Mt. View Library **ARTIST OF THE MONTH SHOW.**
