

Fairbanks Scout Troop 10 To Display Space Show

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Through the efforts of Congressman Howard W. Pollock with the National Aeronautics and Space Administration, a Fairbanks Boy Scout troop will undoubtedly be the envy of all scouting units in Alaska.

Scoutmaster Douglas E. Holman of Troop 10 Midnight Sun Council enlisted Congressman Pollock's assistance in securing adequate display materials for the troop in the annual SCOUT - O - RAMA to be held in Fairbanks this Spring.

Pollock took the Scoutmaster's request to officials of NASA, and, as a result, NASA is sending the troop a complete poster and photographic display of the U.S. Space Exploration Program.
