A pre-med student from Galena has been admitted to a summer Health Careers Program sponsored by the Harvard Medical School and the Harvard School of Dental Medicine.

Claude Demientieff, a native, and freshman at the University of Alaska, will attend an eight-week session from June 24 to Aug. 21 designed to strengthen a student's academic preparation in science

and mathematics for a career in medicine or dentistry.

Harvard will cover the expenses of room and board, tuition, books and lab fees.

At Harvard, Demientieff, along with the other students in the program, will take introductory or intermediate level courses in biology, chemistry and mathematics and will be exposed to hospitals and laboratories.
