

Wien Consolidated Plans Increase Of Flights to Juneau on May 26

Beginning May 26 Wien Consolidated Airlines will increase the number of flights between Fairbanks, Whitehorse and Juneau from three to five flights weekly, daily Monday through Friday, according to A.E. (Bud) Hagberg, vice-president—marketing.

At the same time an additional

B-737 jet flight to Barrow will be added making a total of eight flights weekly. Service to Nome and Kotzebue will be daily with the addition of a Sunday flight.

On the same date B-737 jet service will be inaugurated to St. Mary's on the Lower Yukon, Hagberg said.
