

Conference On Aging and Retirement

The first All-Alaska Conference on Aging and Retirement will be held November 21-23 in Anchorage, Alaska.

Government and volunteer officials with duties relating to the elderly, students, and elderly people, including 12 native leaders from outlying villages will participate in the Conference.

The Conference is being sponsored by Alaska Methodist University, the Older Persons Action Group and the Anchorage Chapter of the American Association of Retired Persons.

Speakers will include Mrs. Milton Schiffman, Western Region Field Representative of the National Council on the Aging, Inc.

The Conference will focus on six major subjects: medicine, including the physiological and psychological aspects of aging; private industry's role in the development of retirement plans for the elderly and the use of the expertise of the elderly; organized labor's role in the development of retirement plans and labor's other responsibilities to the elderly; housing for the elderly; education; and the legislation and recommendations for legislation concerning the elderly.
