

ASSOCIATION, INC., has filed a tariff revision (TA9-17) consisting of roposed interim rates which would increase annual revenues by these approximate percentages:
Residential 5.94 per cent
Public Building 4.58 per cent
Small Commercial 8.34 per cent
The utility states that operations for the first eight months of 1974 have resulted in a loss of \$27,650, which represents 31 per cent of members' equity at January 1, 1974. The utility states that this interim rate relief is necessary to mainain its financial solvency and will be followed by an additional rate filing about the lifst of next year. The existing fuel cost adjustment surharge will not be affected by the interim rate increase.
