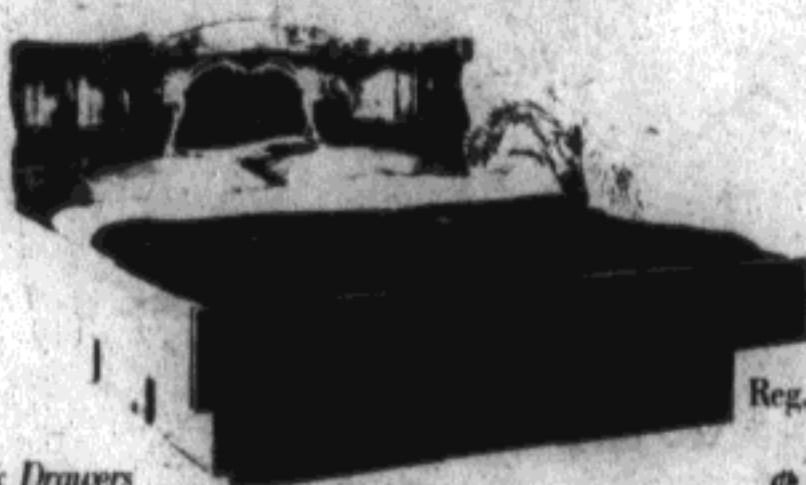

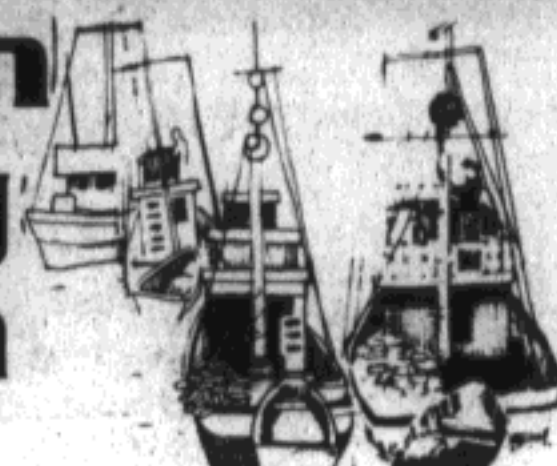

# Oil Exploration in the Bering Sea



## Six Free Programs

As part of its Western Alaska Information Program, the Alaska Oil and Gas Association has prepared six informational videotapes on offshore operations in the Bering Sea. The programs were prepared to provide residents information about what is expected to occur in the area.

## Multi-Image Videotape Slide Programs

1. "Oil and Gas and the Bering Sea" — This 19-minute videotape offers answers from the oil industry to pressing questions raised by Western Alaska residents. Available in half-inch or three-quarter inch tapes, English and Yupik languages.
2. "What Will Happen to the Fish?" — This 12-minute videotape discusses industry experience in fish-rich waters and the likely impact of oil operations on fishing in the Bering Sea. Available in half-inch or three-quarter inch format, English and Yupik languages.

Four live-action programs. Available in half-inch or three-quarter inch videotapes, English, Yupik, or Aleut languages.

3. "A Very Natural Resource" — Introduced offshore oil and its impact. 30 minutes.
4. "Getting Ready" — Details the research, data gathering and precautions taken before offshore drilling starts. 19 minutes.
5. "Exploratory Drilling" — Explains the methods used for probing for offshore oil. 29 minutes.
6. "Developing an Oil Discovery" — Tells what can be expected if oil is actually found in the Bering Sea. 32 minutes.
