

Shively, Johnson on Game Board

Gov. Bill Sheffield has appointed three new members to the Board of Game from a field of 50 candidates. He also said he would retain four current members in their positions.

Sheffield said the new members are Kirk Gay and John Shively, both of Anchorage, and Brenda Johnson of Nome. Remaining on the board are Joel Bennett of Juneau, John Hanson of Alakanuk, Sidney Huntington of Galena and Samuel Harbo Jr. of College.

Last month, Sheffield asked the seven members of the board to step down. He received resignations from all but Harbo, who said state law provides that board members could be removed only for misconduct. Harbo, the current board chairman, has been a board member since 1975.

Gay is a licensed commercial

pilot, master guide and president of Alaska Safari Inc.

Shively is senior vice president of NANA Regional Corp. and a member of several state boards, including the University of Alaska Board of Regents.

Johnson is a Nome businesswoman and member of the Senior Citizens Advisory Board for her community.
