

A REMINDER TO FOOD STAMP RECIPIENTS

Any changes in your circumstances must be reported promptly to the public assistance office. Changes such as an increase or decrease in either income or household size or a new address can be reported by telephone. However, it is better to fill out a change report form and mail it to the office.

It is extremely important that you report changes so that your household receives the right amount of food stamps. If you receive any extra food stamps because you have not reported a change, you will owe the food stamp program the value of these stamps.

There are over 100 changes in this year's tax laws and forms.
