PROGRAM YEAR: OCTOBER 1, 1975 - JUNE 30, 1975

The State Social Services Programs are directed to:

- assist individuals achieve a capability for self-support and self  
sufficiency;
- prevent or remedy the neglect and abuse of children and dependent  
adults;
- provide alternatives within the home and community to  
institutional care;
- meet the needs of those who must, for maximum care, be placed in  
institutions; and
- help preserve or rehabilitate families.

Comprehensive programs with service components are available for all residents of the State. These  
include the Alcantra Youth Campus, Alcoholism, Child Protection, Counseling and Case Management,  
Day Care, Family Planning, Homemaker, Information and Referral, and Supportive Services for Children.

#### ELIGIBILITY

Recipients of AFDC and recipients of SSI/State Supplementary payments are eligible for all provided  
services. Individuals whose annual gross family income is less than 80% of the State median, as adjusted  
for family size, are eligible for all services except Day Care and Homemaker. Families with a gross income  
which lies between 90-115% of the State median, as adjusted for family size, are also eligible for all  
services except Day Care and Homemaker, if they agree to a reasonable fee for services provided. Child  
Protection and Information and Referral will be available to all individuals in need of such services.

Maximum Federal Allotment to the State: \$ 4,000,000  
Estimated State Expenditures: 3,466,100
