

Postsecondary Opportunities

If you would like to go to college, remain in college, or discover other forms of postsecondary educational opportunities, but find educational, financial, or other obstacles in your path, then you should know about three U.S. Office of Education programs which are designed to help persons like yourself.

These programs are Talent Search, Upward Bound, and

Special Services.

Talent Search is designed to help qualified high school students or dropouts in financial or cultural need who have exceptional potential for postsecondary education.

Upward Bound assist students who generally have inadequate secondary preparation but who can achieve academic success by enrolling on a substantially full-time basis during all or part of the program from the 10th through the 12th grades.

Special Services helps students already in college or accepted for enrollment — through counseling, tutorial, and other educational services.

The program is designed to remedy academic deficiencies and to provide career guidance, placement, and other services to encourage them to continue (or re-enter) higher education.
