

Athabascan Culture Book

A 53 page publication of teaching ideas and materials listing on Athabascan culture has been made available for distribution to Interior Alaska schools.

Printed and distributed by the Alaska Educational Program for Intercultural Communication (AEPIC) of the Center for Northern Educational Research (CNER), the publication is the result of a teacher workshop convened in Fairbanks in March to identify teaching strategies involving community and Athabascan related curricula for elementary and secondary schools.

The publications lists on-going programs in selected Interior schools as well as print and non-print resources available to teachers and students.
