### REQUEST FOR GRANT PROPOSALS COMMUNITY BASED FAMILY RESOURCE PROGRAMS FAMILY PRESERVATION AND SUPPORT; AND PLANNING GRANTS

The Division of Family and Youth Services (DFYS) is requesting grant proposals for three types of grants: Community Based Family Resource Programs, Family Preservation and Support grants, and Planning Grants for planning how to improve the delivery of family preservation and support services within a particular community. Communities are encouraged to collaborate to apply for small amounts of money that will assist in the development of family support services, family preservation services, and family resource centers. Applications are particularly encouraged from smaller communities. The total amount available for each grant type is:

Community Based Family Resource Program Grants:	150,000
Family Preservation and Support Grants:	149,000
✓ Planning Grants:	20,000

For the first two types of grants, proposals in excess of \$50,000 will not be considered. The planning grants will be limited to \$5,000. At least one grant from each category will be awarded in each of the Division's three managerial regions. Deadline for receipt of proposals in Juneau is Thursday, November 30, 1995.
