

NOTICE OF UTILITY TARIFF FILING

The ALASKA PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION hereby gives notice that BARROW UTILITIES AND ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE, INC., an electric utility, has filed a tariff revision (TA6-214) which is a request to reissue its tariff because of numerous changes to the rules and regulations section of the tariff.

The new rules and regulations are divided into the following sections:

- General Provisions
- Application for Services
- Landlord Service Agreement

- Right-of-way

BUECI proposes changes throughout the rules and regulations. One example of a proposed change concerns the line extension policy. Presently, BUECI's tariff provides that the utility will not make additional charges to applicants who may be served by not over two spans of primary or secondary lines. For applicants whose line extension exceeds the basic offering, the utility calculates the cost of the line beyond the 400 feet allowance and amortizes this amount over a period of not more than three years. This added cost is added to the monthly bill of the consumer, but the consumer is entitled to use the amount of his guarantee in electric current. In the new rules and regulations BUECI Proposes a standard offering of one span of secondary to an existing pole; beyond this standard offering the applicant must pay the additional costs of construction.

If after investigation the Commission finds a rate or classification different from that proposed by BUECI is reasonable, the Commission may approve a rate or classification which varies from that proposed.

Any interested person may file a statement of views favoring or opposing this tariff filing with the Alaska Public Utilities Commission on or before February 19, 1986. As required by the Alaska Administrative Code, any statement filed with the Commission should clearly affirm that the interested person has filed a true copy of the statement with BUECI.
