

\$ 1.3 million for employment

The Department of Community & Regional Affairs has been awarded nearly 1.3 million dollars for the summer employment of approximately 3,000 Alaskan youth between the ages of 14 to 21.

Funding for this program was awarded by the Manpower Division in the Office of the Governor under the Federal Comprehensive Employment Training Act.

The program, known as Neighborhood Youth Corps, will provide work experience and summer employment for many economically disadvantaged youth in rural Alaska.
