## More jobs from Interior

The Department of the Interior has notified Sen. Ted Stevens' office in Washington that it will take applications for summer jobs in National Parks between December 1, 1977 and January 15, 1978.

The department stated that during that time period requests for employment should be sent to one of its regional offices, and must be postmarked no later that the closing date of January 15, to receive consideration. The regional office contacted will send the applicant the new form (No. 10-139) that must be completed for rating applications by a centralized computer process to be used for the first time this year.

Each applicant may receive consideration for up to two separate park areas and two types of jobs in each area. Interested persons are encouraged to contact a regional office as soon as possible. The seasonal employment offered each summer by the department receives keen competition by applicants, and Interior suggests that persons applying do so early.
