3) to insure that ultimately alcohol-
ism services respond to and are con-
trolled by the needs established as
medical priorities, and by the func-
tions established as social priorities
by the Native people who are the

recipients of the alcoholism services
provided;

4) to encourage the development of
local responsibility through consumer
managed alcoholism services, serving
appropriate geographical areas within
the region; and,

5) to insure accountability to pro-
gram planning, implementation and
evaluation mechanisms.
