

Suit dropped by Wassman

FROM THE BERING STRAIGHTS

The civil suit filed in Nome Superior Court last March against Jerome Trigg, Thomas Drake, Alfred Nakak and "each and every board member (of Bering Straits Native Corporation) who approved of the business transactions" listed in the derivative action suit on charges of misuse of corporate funds have been dismissed by the plaintiffs (Suzanne Wassman and Suzanne Wassman on behalf of her four children) with the exception of the charges against Alfred C. Nakak.

The stipulation of dismissal (except against Nakak) is subject to the following condition:

"That Plaintiffs and all individual Defendants on whose behalf this Stipulation is entered mutually covenant not to sue each other as respective parties for causes of action that pertain to the allegations contained in this lawsuit."

The suit was filed a week before elections to BSNC's Board of Directors to which Suzanne Wassman was elected.
