- Allocating funds from federal grant programs.
- Identifying areas requiring bilingual education.
- Assessing the need for equal employment opportunity programs.
- Allocating funds and analysis of programs for American Indians and Alaska Natives.

- Identifying areas needing programs to stimulate economic growth.
- Assessing the need for developing or expanding low-income housing programs.
- Identifying areas requiring child assistance programs.

State and Local Government Programs

- Developing social services programs.
- Programs for the elderly and handicapped.
- Establishing occupational and vocational education programs.
- Planning school district boundaries and school construction programs.
- Assessing the need for state housing bonds for below-market interest rates on mortgages.
