Refresher course for nurses offered by UAA

A refresher course for inactive registered nurses will begin Feb. 3 at the University of Alaska, Anchorage. The RN Refresher Course will run through May 5 and is offered by the School of Nursing Continuing Education in the Health Sciences program.

The course is designed to prepare registered nurses who have been away from active practice for several years for re-entry into the profession. Emphasis will be placed upon current trends in nursing practice and education, and the opportunity for updating specific skills and knowledge will be provided.

This 12-week course will include 148 hours of theory, discussions, and seminars through the use of tapes, audio-visuals, and teleconferences. In addition, 120 hours of supervised clinical experience in a local hospital will be required.

Upon successful completion of this course, the participant will be eligible to renew the Alaska State nursing license and will also be awarded 19 Continuing Education Units.
