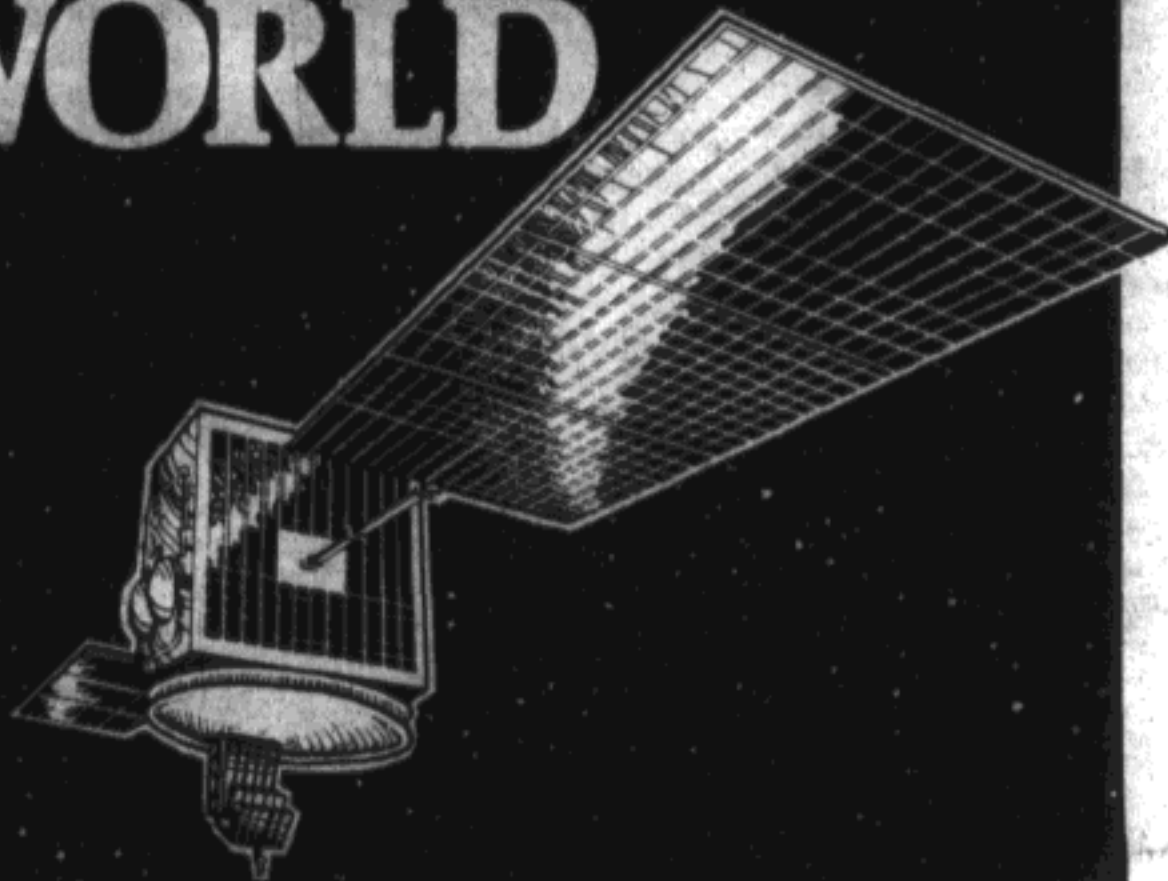


WE NEED A NAME THAT'S OUT OF THIS WORLD



There's still time to name Alascom's new satellite

If you're an Alaskan student from grades K through 12, you have the once-in-a-lifetime opportunity of becoming a part of Alaskan history by naming Alascom's new satellite.

Put on your thinking caps, because the reward is well worth it. If your suggested name is selected by our judges, you and your parents or guardians will be our guests in Washington D.C. for a mini-vacation. In addition, your school will receive \$1,500 to purchase audio-visual equipment.

To enter, fill out the entry form below. In the space provided, explain in 50 words or less why you think the name you selected is the best choice for Alascom's satellite. In case of duplicate entries, earliest postmark will be selected. All entries must be received by December 31, 1982. You may enter as many times as you like, but be certain that each name is on a separate entry form. So put your imagination to work. You'll never get a better chance to place your name among the stars!

CONTEST RULES

1. Name the Alascom satellite. In 50 words or less explain the reason you feel the name is appropriate for Alaska's own satellite.
2. Contest is open to any student from kindergarten through high school.
3. When entering the contest, be certain to submit your name, address, age, and the name of your school.
4. In cases of duplicate names, the entry with the earliest postmark wins. In cases of a tie or ties, a drawing shall determine the winner.
5. Judging will be done by an independent team of journalists who will submit a list of finalists to the Alaska State Chamber of Commerce contest committee for a final selection. The judges' decision is final.
6. Winner and his parents or guardians will be our guests on a tour of Washington, D.C., including the National Space Museum. All transportation and accommodations will be included as part of the prize, as well as \$500 expense money.
7. All entries should be mailed to: Name the Satellite Contest, Pouch 3-4000, Anchorage, AK 99501.
8. You may enter the contest by using an official entry form, or a plain sheet of paper. Entry forms are available at your school.
9. Enter as often as you wish. Each entry must be a separate name and explanation, and must be sent individually.
10. All entries must be received by December 31, 1982.
11. The winner will be notified by January 21, 1983.
