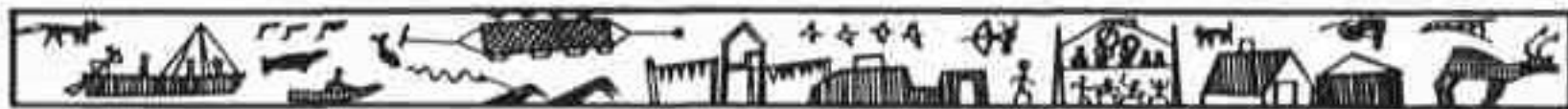

BERING STRAITS NATIVE CORPORATION Higher Education Scholarships

1. Applicant must be 1/4 or more Alaska Native (Aleut, Eskimo, or Indian), and enrolled in a BSNC Village Corporation, as an "At Large" member of BSNC, or a descendant of a shareholder.
2. Applicant must be able to show financial need after other sources of funding have been considered.
3. Applicant must be accepted and enrolled by an accredited institution.
4. Applicant must carry a minimum credit load of 12 hours per semester or 10 hours per quarter and maintain a 2.00 CUMULATIVE grade point average or better.

Exceptions can be made for entering freshmen with the approval of your counselor and the Bering Straits Native Corporation Scholarship Committee. You must send this office a copy of your transcript at the end of each term.

1. **DEADLINE** for applying is 6/30/90.
2. Complete the attached application and return it to this office.
3. Apply for other sources of financial aid from the following, if you are eligible: a) Veteran's Administration, 709 W. 9th St. Juneau, AK 99802, b) Alaska Student Loan, Alaska Post Secondary Commission, Student Finan-

4. Send us TWO letters of recommendation from persons who have known you for at least five years and are, preferably, from the following: Local school board, teacher, principal, counselor, village corporation, village council, regional non-profit, etc.
5. Send your transcript from EACH college that you have attended (or high school if this will be your first year in college.)
6. A short statement, in your own words, expressing your career goals.
