Mrs. Padilla has been an active worker in Alaska's anti-poverty program since 1969. She recently obtained funds for an alcoholism program in her area which now has the assistance of a full-time counselor.

In cooperation with the Of-fice of Feonomic Opportunity, she established an assistance pro-gram for semor citizens. The gram for senior citizens. The program provides the elderly with recreational activities, medi-

with recreational activities, medi-cal and dental care and hot meals.

As coordinator of multi-agency effort, Mrs. Padilla was instrumental in bringing the prevention education to the people in rural villages. Through her office, planning and eco-nomic development is handled for 11 villages. This includes referral services, housing, child care, job training and employ

Due to a late start, federal funds were due to expire October 30 with the project only 75 per cent complete.




