

# Mental Institute Recruiting Indians

The Consortium of Texas Graduate Schools of Social Work is currently involved in a program funded by the National Institute of Mental Health that involves the recruitment of economically disadvantaged students, including Mexican Americans, American Indians, and Blacks, into graduate social work education.

Stipends of \$200 per month including tuition and depend-

ence allowances of \$50 per month are provided through this program.

In addition, applicants are eligible for other stipends provided by the schools.
