Notice of Local Liquor Option Election

Notice is hereby given that pursuant to the provisions of AS 04.11.500 and AS 04.11.502, an election will be held in Kipnuk on July 13, 1982 to vote on the following question:

"Shall the sale and importation of alcoholic beverages be prohibited in Kipnuk? (yes or no)"

The election will be under the administration and supervision of the Office of the Lieutenant Governor, Division of Elections.

Any person who is a qualified voter in Alaska and who has resided within a five-mile radius of the post office station in Kipnuk for 30 days may vote in the election.

The election will be conducted in the general manner as prescribed by the Alaska Election Code. There will be one polling place.
