Inactive Registered Nurses Offered Refresher Course

A class is being planned to prepare registered nurses who have been away from active practice for several years for re-entry into the profession.

The Refresher Course for Registered Nurses will be sponsored by the Anchorage Higher Education Consortium from July 7-Aug. 15. Classroom studies will be held at the Anchorage Community College.

Clinical work will be done primarily at Providence Hospital along with the Greater Anchorage Area Borough Health Department, Alaska Treatment Center for Crippled Children and Adults and the Alaska Kidney Center.

The opportunity to review and update nursing knowledge and skills will be given the students in order that they may return to practice in today's health care

settings.

Emphasis will be given to trends in nursing care; nursing practice, and nursing education, as well as to the updating of specific knowledge and skills such as pharmacology, cardio-pulmonary care and critical care.

Eligibility for enrollment will be determined by inactivity from nursing practice for at least five years; inability to gain employment without such a course; the need for relicensure to practice as a professional nurse in the State of Alaska; practice in a specialty area, or an expressed need or desire to return to active practice.

The lecture portion of the class will constitute six hours a week with 28 hours devoted to clinical laboratory work. Twelve Continuing Education units will

be earned through the course.
