

# Maintained Road System

Commissioner Walter Parker recently announced that due to the accelerated deterioration of the Alaska road system he has requested his staff start an immediate review of the State-maintained road system.

The principal purpose of the review will be to eliminate from the State-maintained system, including federal-aid roads, those roads which are more properly local roads.

The anticipated reduction in the mileage of the State-maintained system is to allow the Department of Highways to concentrate its

efforts in an effective maintenance program on the remaining system to preclude its rapid destruction.
